This summer, children don't just attend camp, they embark on a journey across the world.

Week 2: Great Buildings of the World

25th May - 29th May

How imagination shapes iconic structures

Children discover how human creativity and collaboration have built some of the world's greatest monuments.

- France - The Eiffel Tower
- China - The Great Wall
- UAE - The Burj Khalifa



Through construction challenges and design thinking, children strengthen spatial awareness, teamwork, and problem-solving.

Week 3: Wonders of Time and Sky

1st June - 5th June

History, rhythm, and the magic above us

Children explore the connection between time, history, and the sky.

- Italy - The Colosseum
- United Kingdom - Big Ben
- USA - The Statue of Liberty
- Iceland - The Northern Lights
